

## Installing Applied Ballistics Analytics on a Mac

1. Important Note: Read all prompts in the terminal carefully, some will prompt you to press enter to “Accept” and some will prompt you to input your password. Please pay attention to these prompts and follow them.
2. Open up a terminal window. Install homebrew via this command:
  - a. `/usr/bin/ruby -e "$(curl -fsSL https://raw.githubusercontent.com/Homebrew/install/master/install)"`
  - b. Instructions for this can be found here if you need a hand... <http://brew.sh/>
3. Install Wine through homebrew.
  - a. Type these commands:
    - i. `brew doctor`
    - ii. `sudo xcodebuild –license`
      1. Some users might have to install xcode, you can find this in iTunes.
    - iii. `brew install wine`
4. Wine should now be installed on your system. Note that it will take a while for it to do this install since it is building. Download the AB Analytics package here:
  - a. [AB Analytics Download](#)
    - i. Put this in your downloads folder.
5. In your terminal window, go to your Downloads folder by typing:
  - a. `cd Downloads`
  - b. then type: `wine ABAnalytics.exe`
6. Choose to unzip the files to the Downloads directory (use the default value already here to do that)
7. Now, change directories to the AB Analytics executable folder by typing:
  - a. `cd “AB Analytics:`
  - b. then type: `cd App`
8. Now execute the AB App by typing:
  - a. `wine abm_win.exe`
9. Once it is setup all you need to do is execute it out of the terminal window. When you want to run it, just follow steps 4 – 7.
